Day Six: delivering vital medical equipment and supplies to a Field Hospital near Kherson...







This field hospital, which serves both civilians and the military, has been the persistent target of Russian rocket and missile attacks, including one missile strike that occurred only two hours before we arrived.





...and delivering food, clothing, personal items and other humanitarian aid to villages along the front lines the day after Russian soldiers de-occupied them. After nearly one month of Russian occupation, the conditions we found in these villages was often horrific, as these villagers suffered the worst of the intentional genocide at the hands of the Russian forces.











The assistance we received from Lilia Bondarenko, the Assistant to Governor Kim, was just one example of the incredible support given to our Mission by Ukrainian government officials. Undeterred by artillery explosions and Russian missiles streaking overhead, Lilia bravely guided us through the front lines.
